Scope: This statement outlines the Network’s alignment with Durham College’s sustainability and community-engagement priorities.

The [Durham College Student Association’s Campus Druid Network](#) recognizes the environmental and community stewardship principles reflected within Durham College’s [DC 2030 Strategic Vision](#) and the college’s signing of the [United Nations Sustainable Development Goals Accord](#).

In alignment with Durham College’s participation in the [2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development](#), the Campus Druid Network supports educational, cultural, and community initiatives which encourage respect for the natural world, personal wellbeing, and responsible stewardship of land and shared spaces.

While the SDGs are framed around 2030, the Network affirms these commitments as ongoing responsibilities that extend beyond 2030.

Starting last month, each event will be aligned with at least one Sustainable Development Goal. A running index will record every event and its alignment, and this record will be reported annually to the Durham College Student Association, and EDI Office.
